HIGHLIGHTS

- Enrollment for Fall 2012 is at an all-time high, with a total of 21,528 students -- an increase of 684 students or 3.3% over last fall.
- Enrollment has grown by an astounding 43.9% over the past decade, growing from 14,960 in 2002.
- Minority enrollment grew by 5.7% (286 students) from Fall 2011 to Fall 2012 to a University high of 5,340.
- A record 2,734 students are enrolled at the UM Medical Center in Jackson, up by 114 students (4.6%) over last fall.
- For this year's freshmen class, the average ACT score is 23.8 and Overall High School GPA is 3.43 -- both of which are the highest in UM history.
- Demand remains strong at UM's Regional Campuses: Tupelo (905 students), Southaven (923 students), Booneville (89 students), and Grenada (110 students).




