HIGHLIGHTS

- Enrollment for Fall 2013 is at an all-time high, with a total of 22,291 students -- an increase of 763 students or 3.5% over last fall.
- Enrollment has grown by an astounding 35.1% over the past decade, and by 21.5% in the past five years alone.
- UM's First Year retention rate jumped dramatically from 80.8% to 85.6% from Fall 2012 to Fall 2013.
- A record 2,860 students are enrolled at the UM Medical Center in Jackson, up by 126 students (4.6%) over last fall.
- For this year's freshmen class, the average ACT score is 24.1 and Overall High School GPA is 3.46 both of which are the highest in UM history.
- Demand remains strong at UM's Regional Campuses: Tupelo (736 students), DeSoto (731 students), Booneville (67 students), and Grenada (117 students).





FIVE YEAR NEW FRESHMEN TRENDS





