THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI, ORGANIZATION CHARTS

In September 1995, Chancellor Robert Khayat launched a significant reorganization of the University's administrative structure. Some of the refinements are highlighted below:

Highlights:

- 1) The position of Provost/Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs was re-established as the administrative officer to whom the Vice Chancellors for Student Life, University Relations, and Research report.
- 2) The only Vice Chancellor reporting directly to the Chancellor is the Vice Chancellor for Administration and Finance.
- 3) Within the Office of the Provost/Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs:
 - The position formerly listed as Associate Provost and Associate Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs became the Associate Provost and Dean of the Graduate School.
 - The position formerly listed as Assistant to the Provost became Assistant Provost.
 - The position formerly shown as Associate Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs became Associate Provost and was refocused upon financial and administrative affairs within the Office of the Provost.
- 4) The extensive process re-engineering taking place at the University of Mississippi has led to additional administrative adjustments with other potential changes to take place in the future.
