


THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI

ENROLLMENT STATUS OF MEMBERS OF ENTERING FRESHMEN CLASS FALL SEMESTER 1995 AND AT THE END OF EACH OF THE NEXT SIX YEARS



Continuing Enrollment: The proportion of students entering as full-time freshmen in the fall semester 1995 who were enrolled in fall semester of subsequent years. Hence, 62% of those students entering as full-time freshmen in the fall semester 1995 continued their enrollment after two years in the fall semester 1997.

Graduated: The proportion of students entering as full-time freshmen in the fall semester 1995 who had graduated. Hence, 33% of those full-time freshmen entering in the fall semester 1995 had graduated by the fall semester 1999.

Academic Dismissal: The proportion of students entering as full-time freshmen in the fall semester 1995 who did not return following their dismissal for academic reasons. Of those full-time freshmen entering in the fall semester 1995, 8% had left the University following academic dismissal.

Voluntary Withdrawal: The proportion of students entering as full-time freshmen in the fall semester 1995 who (though in good academic standing) chose not to continue their enrollment at the University. By the fall semester 1997, 32% of those full-time freshmen who entered in the fall semester 1995 had voluntarily discontinued enrollment.
