### **HIGHLIGHTS**


- Enrollment for Fall 2015 is at an all-time high, with a total of 23,838 students -- an increase of 742 students or 3.2% over last fall.
- Enrollment has grown by an astounding 38% over the past decade, and by 14% in the past five years alone.
- UM's First Year retention rate has increased drastically from 80.8% in for the 2011 cohort to 86.5% for the latest cohort.
- A record 3,011 students are enrolled at the UM Medical Center in Jackson, up by 27 students over last fall.
- For this year's freshmen class, the average ACT score is 24.7 and Overall High School GPA is 3.54 both of which are the highest in UM history.
- Demand remains strong at UM's Regional Campuses: Tupelo (662 students), DeSoto (653 students), Booneville (61 students), and Grenada (109 students).




