#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Enrollment for Fall 2016 is at an all-time high, with a total of 24,250 students -- an increase of 412 students or 1.7% over last fall.
- 2,990 students are enrolled at the UM Medical Center in Jackson.
- Enrollment has grown by an astounding 40.5% over the past decade, and by 13.1% in the past five years alone.
- For this year's freshmen class, the average ACT score is 25.2 and overall high school GPA is 3.57 both of which are the highest in UM history.
- Demand remains strong at UM's regional campuses: Tupelo (678 students), DeSoto (648 students), Booneville (76 students), and Grenada (101 students).
- UM's first year retention rate has increased drastically from 80.8% for the 2011 cohort to 85.3% for the 2015 cohort.
- $\bullet$  Four-year graduation rate for new freshman is at an all-time time high of 43.8%




